



# **Sports Premium Funding Plan**

**2016 - 2017**

The Government is providing funding to provide new, substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school head teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

## **Our estimated PE and Sports Premium funding for the academic year 2016-2017 is £9750**

### **Purpose of the funding**

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. Possible uses for the funding include:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- new or additional Change4Life sport clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and holiday clubs

At Kings Road Primary School, we believe that all children should be given the opportunity to develop their sporting skills. We work in partnership with many sporting organisations offering a range of sports. We offer many clubs before, during and after the school day. We have also implemented a Change4Life club in the past year which has been very successful. As a school we enter many competitions, always doing our very best and learning from the experience.

## **Last Year Kings Road Primary School used the additional funding to:**

- employ a qualified Sports Coach to help enrich our PE lessons.
- focussed staff CPD delivered by qualified sports coaches.
- employ a qualified Sports Coach to set up and run additional sports clubs during the school day.
- employ a qualified Sports Coach to facilitate and prepare children for competitions.
- extend our inter-house competitions
- extend the change4life provision to ensure even greater levels of physical activity
- run sessions for gifted and talented pupils

## **Impact:**

- We have taken part in over 30 competitions, ranging from tag rugby, basketball, cricket, tennis and district sports to name a few.
- We have taken the Olympic torch from school to school, and held our own Road to Rio to get the children inspired for the Olympic Games. The Olympic Theme also ran into our sports day with a brilliant carnival atmosphere, and we finished off with our Running Races from each year group.
- Year 2 have taken part in Mini Games, Year 4 have taken part in Superstars, we have raised money for Sport Relief holding our own Triathlon, and also our Race 4 Life raising money for cancer charities.
- Year 4 became ice skating champions, having 6 weeks of skating at Riverside Ice Rink.
- Year 5/6 took part in sports at KEGS led by their sports leaders.
- We have played hockey at the Olympic Park, taken part in Orienteering at Maldon Prom, and taken part in the Change 4 Life and All Inclusive Festivals.

- We have won the KS1 Tag Rugby Competition, reached the county finals of the 3 Tees Cricket and the Quad Kids Athletics Event held at Basildon Sporting Village.
- 46% of children have taken part in a level 2 Competition, this is an increase of 7% from last year.
- We have had a number of coaches coming into school delivering high class coaching, FA Football Skills, and Essex Cricket Club.
- Our Club timetable has grown with 48% of children taking part in before or after school activities, an increase of 8% from last year.
- Our Sports Crews have grown, and all of the children have done a great job arranging fun activities at lunchtime.
- All pupils were taught one lesson per week by a qualified Sports Coach.
- All staff had the opportunity to team teach with the Sports Coach and therefore the quality of teaching of PE across the school has improved and staff confidence has also improved.
- We have achieved our 'Gold' Kite Mark Award!
